Nine ways to encourage professional growth

- 1. Encourage interaction among professionals of the same specialty within your organization.
- 2. Promote membership in professional societies and attendance at local society meetings.
- 3. Reward publication of articles in professional journals.
- 4. Pay for the cost of attending significant professional conferences.
- 5. Encourage staff to present papers or speak at conferences and local society meetings.
- 6. Allow professionals to teach a course in local colleges.
- 7. Set up a mentorship program in which senior professionals are paired with junior professionals in the same field and spend time with them.
- 8. Publish a technical journal with contributions from your staff.
- 9. Provide internal recognition for individual professional achievements, including:

Publication of articles in trade journals Presentation of papers at conferences

Publication of articles in refereed journals

Completion of formal technical disclosures (prior to patent applications)

Completion of patent applications

Nomination to Senior or Fellow status in professional societies Receipt of professional awards
